

Biography of Joong-Won Park

Joong-Won Park is a Principal Scientist of the National Cancer Center, Korea and a Professor of Graduate School of Cancer Science and Policy, NCC Korea. He was the Head of the Center for Liver Cancer, NCC, Korea from 2002 to 2010, and was the Head of Translational and Clinical Research at the National Cancer Center Research Institute. Dr Park completed his Medical degree at Seoul National University followed by a residency in Internal Medicine and a Clinical Fellowship in Hepatology at Seoul National University Hospital. He completed a PhD in Medicine at Seoul National University. He was an Assistant and Associate Professor of Chung-Ang University Medical College and was a Visiting Scientist at the Center for Basic Research in Digestive Diseases, Mayo Clinic, Rochester, USA. Research interests are the management of hepatocellular carcinoma and hepatocarcinogenesis. He published about 180 research papers, and these were cited more than 7800 times.

He is a Chair of the Scientific Committee of Asian-Pacific Primary Liver Cancer Experts (APPLE), and a Governing Board member of International Liver Cancer Association (ILCA). He is a Chair of the Committee for the Hepatocellular Carcinoma Management Guidelines of the KLCA-NCC Korea since 2003 and also served as Chair of the Committee for the HBV Chronic Hepatitis Management Guidelines of the Korean Association for the Study of the Liver (KASL). He was a President of Korea Liver Cancer Association (KLCA) 2017-2018.
