PROFILE

In the past ten years, Professor Ya-jin Chen have done over 1000 cases of laparoscopic liver resections, including some complicated cases such as laparoscopic resections of right lobe and caudate lobe, even laparoscopic right trisectionectomy. He reported the first case of Laparoscopic Associating Liver Partition and Portal Vein Ligation for Staged Hepatectomy (ALPPS) for HCC in China in August 2013. He hosted Lingnan HBP Summit Forum of Minimally Invasive Surgery every year, it was the first domestic academic exchange platform of HBP Minimally Invasive Surgery which promoted the professional development of Minimally Invasive Surgery in China. So far he took in charge in three National Natural Science Foundation of China, and won the Second Award of Guangdong Provincial Science and Technology Progress.
